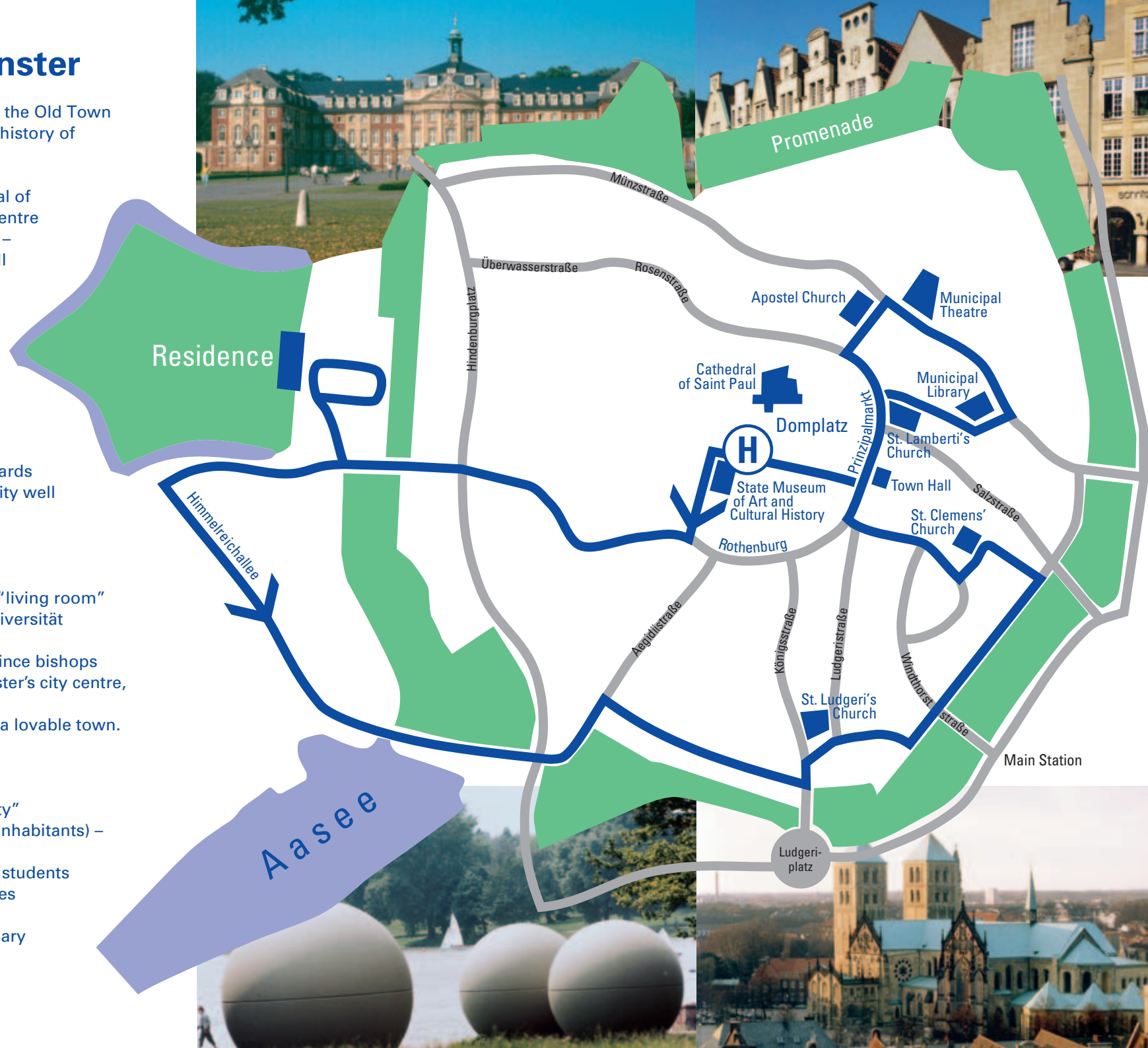

Price per ticket

Adults 8,50 € each

Children (4–14 years of age) 4 € each

Families (two adults with children of their own up to 14 years of age) 16 € each

A ticket also serves as a voucher for a free cup of coffee at the Cafe Kleimann, Prinzipalmarkt, or for a small glass "Stadtbier hell" (pale City Beer) at Pinkus, town-hall, Klemensstraße.

Please note: the vouchers are not offered during the christmas markets.

Bookings /reservations can be made up to two days before a fixed tour with the Münster Tourist / City Information (Heinrich-Brüning-Str.9, opposite Karstadt), through phone **+49 (0)251/6867449** or internet (www.muensteraner-stadtrundfahrten.de). Please, note that a fee is due for each booking/reservation: 1 € per person or 2 € per family.

Tours for groups consisting of ten or more persons can only be arranged with advance notice not later than two days before a tour is going to be made.
